

## Multiple Track Recording WITH METRONOME

NOTE: If recording in  $\frac{3}{4}$  time you must choose a waltz music style in the music style section before beginning the recording process.

### Track One

1. Turn METRONOME on
2. Turn COUNT IN on  
(Push the Count In/Marker button, then use + to turn Count In on.)
3. Push RECORD (window will say "New Song")
4. Use the tone buttons to choose a voice (sound) for recording
5. When ready to record, push PLAY  
(Allow TWO measures of COUNT IN, then begin playing/recording)
6. When you have completed recording the part, push STOP.
7. If you wish to hear the recorded part push PLAY.
8. If while listening to the recorded part you stop playback before the end, make sure to push RESET to set the song back to the beginning.  
(NOTE: If the song plays to the end, the KR-103 will automatically set the song back to the beginning.)

### Tracks 2 – 16

- (METRONOME and COUNT IN are still on)
1. Push RECORD (window will say "New Song")
  2. Use the > (right arrow) key to change window to say "SOLO". At the bottom of the window 2 will be flashing.
  3. Use the tone buttons to choose a voice (sound) for recording.
  4. Push PLAY.  
(Allow THREE measures of COUNT IN, then begin playing/recording)
  5. When you have completed recording the part, push STOP.
  6. To add additional tracks (parts) repeat steps 1 through 5. As you choose SOLO for additional tracks the KR-103 will automatically choose the next track and indicate its number by flashing it in the lower portion of the window. Completed tracks will be indicated by a solid (non-flashing) number in the window.
  7. When all tracks are complete
    - a. Turn METRONOME off
    - b. Turn COUNT IN off
  8. Save your recording to a floppy disk using the procedure on page 5.

### Saving to disk:

1. Place a FLOPPY DISK in the disk drive.
2. Press the DISK button
3. Use the L/R arrow buttons to select SAVE SMF
4. Use the +/- buttons to select the song number for saving.
5. Press ENTER.
6. Use the +/- and L/R arrow buttons to name the song file.
7. Press ENTER to complete naming and saving the song file.
