Concept Map Development (10 points)

- Provide a concept map of your Web Site using Inspiration Software

Analysis of Browsers (10 points)

- Compare and Contrast a Web Site of your choice using two different browsers. For example, you can use Internet Explorer, Netscape, Mozilla, Safari or any two browsers you wish. You should concentrate on the display of the content and the similarities and differences between the displayed pages for the end user.

Web Space/Intro Page (20 points)

- Obtain Web space on a UTEP machine or your own domain and work on a basic default.htm page

Basic Web Site Analysis (20 points)

- Write an overview of your proposed site and include diagrams of the macro (site layout) and micro structure (page layout). You should include this as a single document in MS Word with the images pasted into the text. The overview should include the purpose and theme of your Web site, as well as any specific information needed to be understood from a developer's perspective.

Basic Web Site Implementation (20 points)

- Successfully load your Web Site to date onto your Server space, and test the links and graphics, to make sure all are working properly

Reflection Paper (40 points)

- Write a 3-5 page essay that describes your personal understanding of Web Site Development, and use the five basic areas; planning, research, development, refinement and implementation as organizational frameworks for your paper.
